Instructions Rear Swaybar Kit

N.B: This instruction sheet should be used in conjunction with the workshop manual and proper safety procedures followed.

Raise vehicle evenly and safely support.

Never rely on a Jack only

Note - the new swaybar may be easier to install when vehicle is at ride height (on ramps). - due to less clearance when wheels are at full droop.

- Remove original swaybar including links and the upper brackets.
- Re-use upper link brackets and mount bolts Refer image #1. Note the wider bushing sits in upper link bracket.
- Grease link bushing side faces. Also grease new mount bushings.

Grease bushing face

- Bolt up links to vehicle. Then proceed to bolt up new swaybar.
- Place new large washer against link and smaller washer against swaybar.
- Test drive, then re-check bolts after 100kms.
