## **Fitting Instructions**

## SHOCK MOUNT TO CONTROL ARM BUSHING

To suit: Chrysler/Dodge

## **Contents:**

4 x Replacement Bushings 3107

1 x Fitting Instructions

2 x Crush Tubes

1 x Grease Satchel

4 x Washers

These instructions are to be used in conjunction with Workshop manual.

- 1. Raise the front of the vehicle and support on chassis stands. Remove the front wheels.
- 2. Remove the lower control arm from the ball joint using a suitable puller.
- 3. Remove the front strut lower retaining bolt.
- 4. Remove the front sway bar D bushes and mounts to allow access to lower control arm bolt.
- 5. Remove the lower control arm inner bolt.
- 6. Remove the lower arm from the vehicle.
- 7. Using a suitable press and tools, press the lower shock bush out of the arm and discard.
- 8. Make sure all surfaces are free dirt, burrs and sharp edges.
- 9. Install the replacement **3107** bush into the arm.
- 10. Press the bush in until it centralises in the arm.
- 11. Lubricate the bore and operational faces of the replacement **3107** bush and install the crush tube.
- 12. Re- fit the lower control arm to the vehicle. Lubricate and fit supplied washers to either side of the **3107** bush and re-fit bolt.
- 13. Re-fit wheels.
- 14. Lower vehicle and allow to settle.
- 15. Tighten all bolts to manufacturers' specs and carry out a wheel alignment.
- 16. Road test re-check bolts after 100km travelled.





NB: It is recommended that a licensed workshop or trades person carry out the above procedure and that workshop manual procedures are followed in addition to the above.
