Parts Included with the PERRIN License Plate Delete:

- (1) PERRIN License Plate Delete for 2018+ Crosstrek
- (2) Rubber Inserts
- (2) 10-32x3/4" Black Oxided SS Button Head Screws

Installation of PERRIN License Plate Delete

- 1. Remove existing front license plate from car.
- 2. Install rubber inserts:
 - a. Locate holes and enlarge holes using a 3/8" drill bit, then place rubber inserts into holes as shown above.
 - b. You can force the rubber inserts into each hole without drilling by using a small amount of grease on the body outside of the insert. The only downfall to doing this method is they may be very difficult to remove later.



- 3. Decide which side of plate you want showing and using supplied screws, mount plate to car.
- 4. As you tighten the screws, the rubber inserts will start to compress and start to grab onto backside of bumper. Simply hand tighten screws until you feel a good amount of resistance. **Note: Just keep in mind that overtightening them can damage the inserts. See picture below showing how they work.**



Picture above shows what insert looks like from behind the bumper.

5. After a few days of driving, check that screws are still tight to ensure plate doesn't fall off car.
