TRIM CLIP TOOL 7MM SOCKET

T15 TORX 8MM SOCKET

2.5MM ALLEN KEY 10MM SOCKET

3MM ALLEN KEY

INSTALL TIME: 1 HOUR

INSTALL DIFFICULTY: O O O O

- Raise vehicle only on jack stands or a vehicle lift. Never use only a jack.
- > Allow vehicle to completely before attempting installation
- Do not run engine or drive vehicle while overheating, as serious damage may occur.
- > Please dispose of any liquids properly.

INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

1. Remove the two pop clips and pull the air duct out using a trim clip tool.



2. Unplug the MAF sensor connector and using an 8mm socket, loosen the hose clamp.



3. Using a 10mm socket, remove the air box mounting nut and two bolts. Disconnect the intake pipe and remove the airbox.





4. Using a 10mm socket, remove this bolt.



5. Using an 8mm socket, loosen the hose clamp on the intake pipe.



6. Using a 10mm socket, remove the nut for the intake pipe and pull the intake pipe out.



7. Using a T15 Torx, remove the two MAF sensor screws and remove the sensor from the airbox.



8. Undo the two airbox clips and separate the two halves. Using a 10mm socket, remove the rubber mount nut and mount.



9. Remove the two rubber bushings from the airbox by first pushing the metal sleeve out.



10. Assemble the provided M4 and M5 hardware with lock washers and flat washers.



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11. Use a 3mm Allen to install the three brackets to the airbox with the provided M5 hardware.



12. Install the rubber bushings from the stock airbox into the two bottom brackets.



13. Using a 10mm socket, install the rubber mount from the stock airbox with the shouldered side in the slot.





14. Using a 2.5mm Allen install the stock MAF sensor into the supplied intake pipe.



15. Install the coupler with the stepped side (left) facing the turbo and slide two of the hose clamps on (right). Use a 7mm socket to tighten the hose clamp on the turbo side but leave the other loose.





16. Slide the intake pipe into the coupler and, using a 10mm socket, fasten it with the factory nut (left). Then, connect the MAF sensor plug (right).





17. Using a 10mm socket. Install the airbox using the factory hardware and mount points.



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18. Install the filter and use a 8mm socket to tighten the filter hose clamp. Center the filter in the airbox, so there is an equal distance on either side to prevent touching.



19. Once centered, use a 7mm socket to tighten the hose clamp for the intake pipe.



20. Using a 2.5mm Allen, install the airbox lid with the provided M4 hardware. Don't over-tighten. Install the factory airbox duct and pop clips.



21. This concludes the installation.
